



**State Immunization Requirements
Notice of Noncompliance**

Dear Administrator of _____ Elementary School District,

This letter is to inform you of students attending your school who are noncompliant with state immunization requirements for school attendance.

The California Health and Safety Code requires the exclusion of students who are not fully immunized. This law applies to entering kindergarten students and students repeating kindergarten. Since fall of 1999, this law has also applied to all students entering the 7th grade. Your school may be subject to loss of ADA, through audit exceptions, for these students. These audit exceptions may be retroactive to the student's first date of entry into kindergarten or into the 7th grade.

A parent or legal guardian may elect to exempt their child from immunization requirements. The parent/legal guardian must personally sign the affidavit on the back of the student's School Immunization Record (Blue Card).

The following students should be excluded from school attendance until the school receives proof of their compliance with state immunization requirements:
