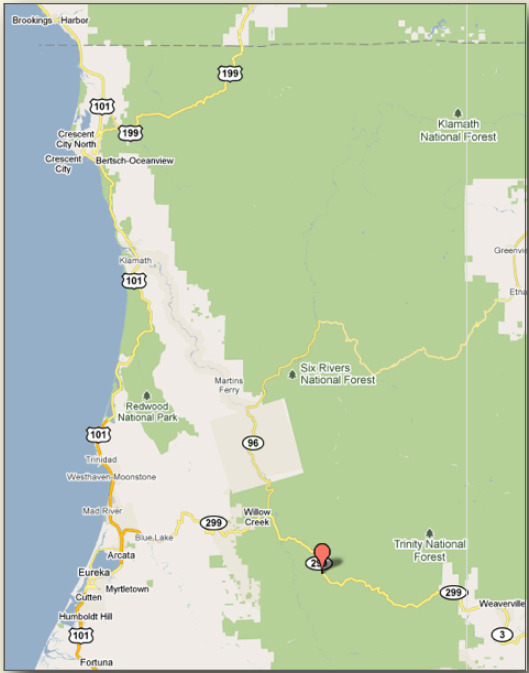

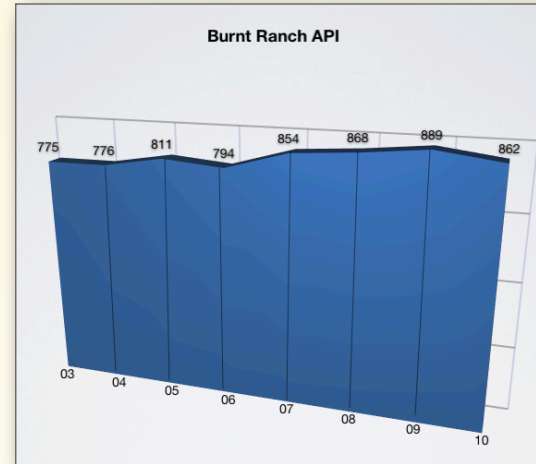
Burnt Ranch School District is a one-school district, Kindergarten through Grade Eight. The school is located in a beautiful, rural area of Trinity County, California. Burnt Ranch has approximately 350 inhabitants.

The school has grown from a one-room schoolhouse in 1895 located near a Chimariko Indian village and the historic Pony Express Trail, to the present facility built in 1962. The school has had other additions built since that time. The campus currently has five classrooms, a multipurpose room with complete kitchen facilities, a small conference room, a library and an administrative building that includes a larger conference area, a small kitchen as well as administrative offices. The school also includes a 2.5-acre playing field, a baseball field, a small basketball court and a playground.

The school currently serves 96 students. 40% of our student body is Native American. Our student-to-teacher ratio for Kindergarten through grade three is at or under 20:1 (twenty students to one teacher). We also average 20:1 in grades four through eight.

The Burnt Ranch staff and community work together to create programs that

produce articulate, confident, responsible and skilled students. The focus is on a well-balanced education for every student with high standards aimed at excellence and student empowerment. An Art teacher and a Physical Education teacher assist classroom teachers in promoting a healthy and creative educational experience for our students.



Burnt Ranch students score extremely well on state tests with an Academic Performance Index (API) of

862 in 2010.

The school offers an after-school program until 6:00 pm each day with enrichment activities for all students. Students can choose to participate in activities such as guitar lessons, soccer class, cooking class, sewing class, mountain biking, and gardening.



We have strong community support with dependable parent involvement. Our community strengths also include our extended families, our alumni, many small businesses, river sports, and a beautiful area in which to live with stores and basic services not far away.
